Introduction

This is a set of practice files used in my video tutorial 'Enhancing Low Light Imagery Tips & Techniques', which can be viewed on YouTube here: <https://youtu.be/LQyaAEi8YG8>

Included are both initial RAW files, which can be loaded into Affinity Photo and developed, then edited further with a non-destructive layer-based workflow.

As an optional download (please check the Gumroad files list), you can also open up the final .afphoto document files. The layer stack is well-organised and labelled so you can easily follow each step of the editing process. They also demonstrate how you can utilise a non-destructive workflow from beginning to end.

Installation

1. Extract all files from the ZIP to a directory of your choice.
2. Open the RAW files in Affinity Photo, either by drag-dropping them onto the interface, or by using **File>Open** and browsing to them.
3. If you wish to view the .afphoto documents to see the non-destructive layer stack, you will require Affinity Photo version 1.9 or later. If you do not have the app, you can download a free trial from <https://affinity.serif.com/photo/#buy>
